## It Begins

- In 1962, President Kennedy announces U.S. intentions to reach the moon
  - No technology existed to support this promise





# Events Leading up to Americans Walking on the Moon

- 1. 1957 The Soviet Union launches Sputnik, the first artificial Earth satellite.
- 2. 1958 The United
  States launches its
  first satellite,
  Explorer I.
  - 1. NASA is formed in the U.S.



## Space Race

- **3. 1959** The Soviet Union launches Luna 2.
  - 1. First space probe to hit the moon

#### 4.1961

- 1. Soviet Yuri Gagarin becomes the first person to orbit the Earth.
- 2. Alan Shepard, Jr. becomes the first American in space.

#### 5. 1962

1. John Glenn, Jr. becomes the first American astronaut to orbit the Earth.





## Space Race

#### 6. 1963

First woman in space is Soviet Valentina Tereshkova.

7. 1968 The U.S. launches Apollo 8, the first manned space mission to orbit the moon.

#### 8. 1969

Apollo 11- U.S. astronauts Neil Armstrong and Edwin "Buzz" Aldrin walk on the moon.




### U.S. wins!
