
• **DSM-IV:** Diagnostic Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders: the big book of disorders.




Two Major Classifications:

 Afflicted people were possessed by evil spirits.




Early Theories




- Music or singing was often used to chase away spirits.
 - In some cases trephening was used:

Cutting a hole in the head of the afflicted to let out the evil spirit.
